DRAMA BYOD Guidelines

Lambton High School is a BYOD School, students are encouraged to bring their own devices to enhance their learning and effective participation in class. In Drama, students' devices are very useful and can be used for numerous activities, including:

- Maintaining a digital theory notebook;
- Collaborating on script development and other group activities;
- Communicating with their teacher;
- Accessing class discussions;
- Filming performances and reflecting on them;
- Accessing scripts and reading materials;
- Viewing videos of other performances;
- Navigating the class website;
- Sending and receiving draft essays;
- Submitting homework items.

In order for the successful implementation of BYOD in Drama, it is important that all students adhere to the following:

- Ensure your device is fully charged before school every day!
- Your device is for school work, you are not to be playing games or using your device to cause distractions or disruptions.
- Keep yourself organised. When you download documents and worksheets, save them in an appropriate folder – they will get confused if you keep them in your 'downloads' folder.
- OneNote is a very useful and powerful tool for keeping yourself organised with school work. You can have all of your subject notes, worksheets, videos, music and other files all saved into one place. You can then save this to a 'cloud' or USB Flash Drive and all of your files will be available to you on any computer.
- If you have a device it is also a good idea to have a 5-subject book in your bag at all times as a backup. This is useful if your device's battery runs flat or is not usable for whatever reason.
- It is essential that you still have pens, rulers and other basic stationary with you every day. There will still be activities in your classes that require these items.

By following these simple guidelines, the implementation of BYOD in Drama will result in a more interactive learning environment and give students more control over their learning.
