D	<ul> <li>At least one obvious attempt is made to answer the question, but the essay lacks further explanation to support for the answer.</li> <li>Some examples are provided but lack further explanation.</li> <li>Attempts are made as using essay structure (e.g. a basic introduction, body paragraphs, or conclusion).</li> </ul>
E	<ul> <li>Essay does not answer the question.</li> <li>Minor, or no, examples appropriate to the response.</li> <li>Informal language is used which detracts from the authority of the response.</li> <li>Lack of essay structure.</li> </ul>
